in either case, not less than 72 hours before the time appointed for holding the AGM, i.e. no later than 10:00 a.m. on 27 April 2024.

- 5. Completion and submission of the instrument appointing a proxy(ies) does not preclude a member from attending and voting at the AGM. The appointment of a proxy(ies) for the AGM will be deemed to be revoked if the member attends the AGM in person and in such event, the Company reserves the right to refuse to admit any persons appointed under the relevant instrument appointing a proxy(ies) to attend the AGM.
- 6. The instrument appointing a proxy(ies) must, if submitted by post or electronically via email, be signed under the hand of the appointor or of his/her attorney duly authorized in writing. Where the instrument appointing a proxy(ies) is executed by a corporation, it must, if submitted by post or electronically via email, be executed either under the common seal or under the hand of its attorney or a duly authorised officer.
- 7. Where an instrument appointing a proxy(ies) is signed on behalf of the appointer by an attorney, the letter or power of attorney or a duly certified copy thereof must (failing previous registration with the Company), if the instrument is submitted by post, be lodged with the instrument or, if the instrument is submitted electronically via email, be emailed with the instrument, failing which the instrument may be treated as invalid.

Members are strongly encouraged to submit completed proxy forms electronically via email.

- 8. A Depositor shall not be regarded as a member of the Company entitled to attend the AGM and to vote thereat unless his name appears on the Depository Register as at 72 hours before the time appointed for holding the AGM.
- 9. The Company shall be entitled to reject the instrument appointing a proxy(ies) which is incomplete, improperly completed, illegible or where the true intentions of the appointor are not ascertainable from the instructions of the appointor specified in the instrument (including any related attachment). In addition, in the case of a member whose shares are entered in the Depository Register, the Company may reject any instrument appointing a proxy(ies) if the member, being the appointor, is not shown to have shares entered against his/her/its name in the Depository Register as at seventy-two (72) hours before the time appointed for holding the AGM, as certified by The Central Depository (Pte) Limited to the Company.
